



TC Health and Safety Facts

- All students **Kindergarten-12th** grade students will be **REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS**. This requirement will be revisited when Marion County's positivity rate is lower and as long as Twin Cedars' staff and student absence rate remains below 10%.
 - Please be sure to send your students with extra face masks in case theirs get soiled.
 - The school/buses does have extra masks available if a child forgets or needs a new one.
 - All face coverings must be school appropriate
 - Acceptable face coverings include: masks, gaiters and bandanas.
 - If a student does not have a mask, the school will provide the student a mask.
 - Preschool students will wear face shields that the school has provided.
- All P-6 students will be provided a face shield that clips to a hat to use during small group activities where the teacher needs to see their mouths. These interactions will be limited to 10 minutes or less.
- All Twin Cedars staff are **REQUIRED** to wear a mask.
- Mask exemptions will be made for students with a written note from a medical doctor.
 - **Twin Cedars staff are NOT able to discuss students medical conditions that warrant a medical exemption.**
- All staff and students will have their temperatures taken upon arrival to the buildings. Any student or staff who has a temperature of 100.4 or higher will have their temperature verified and if it is **100.4 or higher will be sent home.**
- Parents and staff are asked to self screen before coming to the Twin Cedars Campus.
- Visitors to the Twin Cedars campus will be **LIMITED**. Any visitor to the campus will have their temperature checked and be **REQUIRED** to wear a mask when in the buildings.
- Twin Cedars staff and students will continue all other health and safety measures that include:

- All staff and students (parents check students) self symptom check before coming to school; if staff/student is not feeling well or has any symptoms listed on the when to stay home flowsheet stay home or if unsure contact nurse for recommendation.
- Frequent hand washing/hand sanitizing
- Frequent disinfection of frequently touched surfaces
- Use of desk shields in P-6 classrooms
- Social distancing as much as possible.
- Activities
 - All spectators at indoor events will be required to wear face masks and highly encouraged to social distance.
 - The first 2 rows at volleyball games will be blocked off per IGHSAU guidelines.
 - Mask wearing will not be required at football games, however social distancing is highly encouraged.
